

- **Unimog:** Ascend to 8,800 feet with a volcanologist guide for views of ancient craters and fresh lava flows.
- **Hike:** Take a two-hour, medium-difficulty hike to 5,500 feet (500-foot elevation gain hike), exploring Monte Nero's craters and 2002 eruption remnants.
- **Jeep Tour:** Ride through trails with an expert guide to see the 2002 lava flow, Sartorius Mountains and panoramic coastal views.
- **E-Biking:** Join a guided, two-hour e-bike tour through ancient lava fields and lush forests, revealing new sights along the way.
- **Quad Tour:** Begin in Ragabo forest and ride with a guide through black lava fields and dense forests, stopping at scenic viewpoints.
